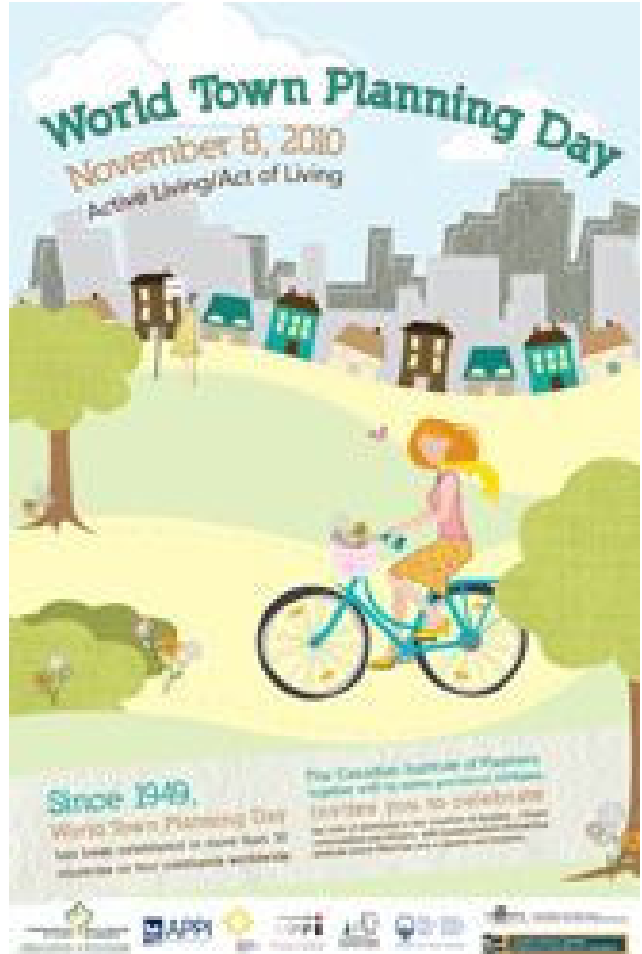
- THE TOWN'S NEW OFFICIAL PLAN -

World Town Planning Day is November 8, 2010. The Canadian Institute of Planners (CIP) supports World Town Planning Day as an opportunity to promote better understanding and awareness of Canadian Planners and planning to the local community and all levels of government. World Town Planning Day is currently celebrated in some manner in about 30 countries on four continents.

World Town Planning Day focuses on the progress of community planning in Canada. It highlights the valuable contributions that sound planning has made to the quality of the human environment and provides recognition of the ideals of community planning among the profession and the general public worldwide.

In recognition of the significance that this day holds for community planning, the Town of Tecumseh Planning Department is hosting a Public Presentation and Discussion on November 8, 2010 from 6:00 to 7:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Town Municipal Office at 917 Lesperance Road to discuss community issues that need to be reflected in the Town's New Official Plan.

The Town's new Official Plan will guide development in the Town over the next 20 years. As an expression of the citizens' vision for their Town, the new Official Plan will contain a policy framework that guides decisions on land use with the objective of creating a healthy, liveable and sustainable community. As a first step to assisting the community in formulating this vision, the Town's Planning Department is seeking input from interested citizens and stakeholders.



The presentation and discussion to take place on November 8 will be framed by the **Planning Context and Issues Report** that was presented to Council earlier this year. This report is the first in a series of discussion papers that will form the basis for policy development in the new Official Plan. It provides background information on the Town and its context in the Essex-Windsor region and identifies relevant issues and emerging trends that will need to be addressed through policy in the new Official Plan.
