



**TOWN OF TECUMSEH
IMPROVEMENTS TO MANNING ROAD
RIVERSIDE DRIVE TO ST. GREGORY'S ROAD
CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT**



Notice of Public Information Centre No. 2

The Town of Tecumseh is completing the planning and design of corridor improvements on Manning Road from Riverside Drive to St. Gregory's Road. Dillon Consulting Limited has been retained to assist the Town in this undertaking. The opportunity to improve this portion of Manning Road arises from the proposed enclosure of the open roadside drain (East Townline Drain) and replacement of the existing pump station outlet, which are being planned and designed separately under the *Ontario Drainage Act*. These drainage improvements will allow for an urban cross section that accommodates pedestrians, cyclists and urban design features to create an aesthetically pleasing gateway.

This project is proceeding in accordance with the planning and design process for a Schedule C project, as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association's *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (2007).

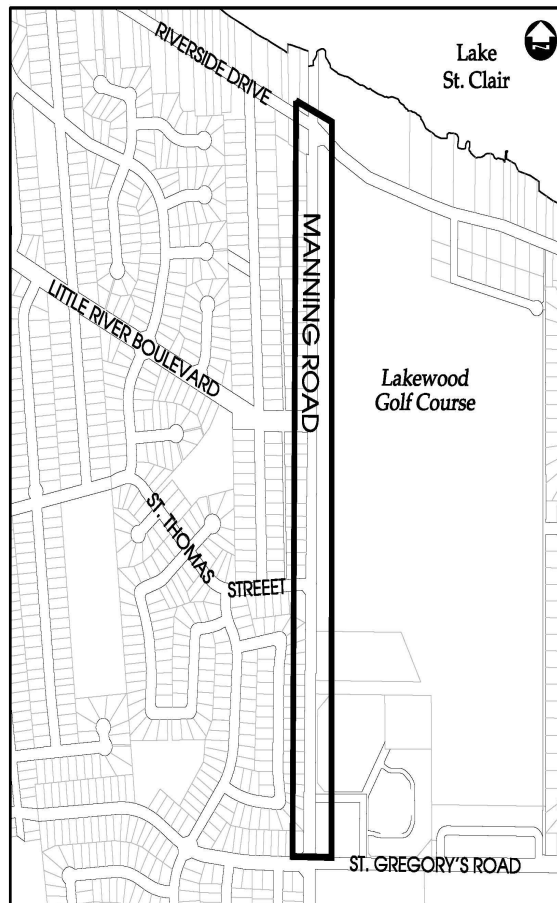
A Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on June 22, 2009 to present the alternatives being considered and to obtain public feedback, based on which the recommended design has been confirmed as follows:

- o Two-lane urban cross section with a continuous mid-block centre median, including a median opening between Little River Boulevard and Riverside Drive;
- o Roundabouts at the St. Thomas, Little River and Riverside Drive intersections;
- o Bikelanes on both sides of the road, as well as a sidewalk along the west side and a multi-use path along the east side; and
- o Urban design features to create an aesthetically pleasing gateway.

Following the PIC, the design will be updated based on comments received and the process leading to the preferred design will be documented in an Environmental Study Report. A notice will be issued in early Fall 2009 advising of the availability of the report for public review and comments.

There is an opportunity at any time during this project for interested persons to review outstanding issues and bring concerns to the attention of the project team. Information collected will be used in accordance with the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.
