NOTICE OF SALE OF LAND

One Foot Reserve – East end of Mero Avenue

The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh (Town) intends to pass a by-law, at its regular meeting to be held on Tuesday, October 12, 2010, at 7:00 p.m., in the Tecumseh Town Hall located at the address indicated below, or as soon thereafter as Council shall determine, to authorize the transfer of the following legally described portion of Mero Avenue to the Ontario Ministry of Transportation (MTO):

One Foot Reserve, Plan 1477, now registered as part 35 on Plan 12R-24022, in the Town of Tecumseh, in the County of Essex (Reserve).

The Reserve is located at the eastern end of Mero Avenue and was originally obtained by the Town in anticipation of the abutting lands to the east being developed and the future extension of Mero Avenue. MTO has requested the transfer of the Reserve to the Ministry to facilitate the construction of The Windsor-Essex Parkway.

On September 28, 2010, Town Council declared the Reserve to be surplus to the needs of the Town. Direction was given to provide notice on the Town's website of the intent to transfer the Reserve to the MTO.

Accordingly, the foregoing Notice is posted to the Town's website.

Town Council shall hear any person who claims their land will be prejudicially affected by the by-law and who applies to be heard by contacting the undersigned, not later than Thursday, October 7, 2010.
