The Tecumseh Distribution System receives treated water from the City of Windsor Drinking Water System through ten direct connections. Drinking Water Works Permit Number 040-201, Issue Number 4 describes the system as having twelve direct connections to the City of Windsor Drinking Water System. However, one interconnecting valve was never installed and one was moved due to construction and is not presently active but can be activated at any time.

The Drinking Water Works Permit should be updated to accurately reflect the system as it is.

The owner did not have evidence that required notifications to all legal owners associated with the Drinking Water System had been made during the inspection period.

The Town of Tecumseh does not provide a copy of their Drinking Water Works Permit and the Municipal Drinking Water License to the legal owners of drinking water infrastructure that has not yet been transferred to the municipality. Brad Dupuis, Manager Water Services, O.R.O., Town of Tecumseh, stated, "The legal possession of the infrastructure by the Town is not established until one year after the completion of construction. However, immediate monitoring and maintenance of the newly installed infrastructure commence upon connection to the Town's infrastructure. This includes activities such as flushing to maintain residuals, conducting locates, winterizing hydrants, and more. It's important to note that the Town strictly prohibits any work or maintenance on water infrastructure, whether private or public, without the presence of a licensed Town operator."

The Town is currently reviewing the non-compliance and plans to submit a formal corrective action report to the Ministry when it is completed.
