



# High Water Level Information Sessions

Record-high lake and river levels are significantly impacting the Windsor-Essex region. Forecasts continue to predict water levels at these unprecedented highs. The potential for localized intense rainfall raises additional concerns. To help residents be as prepared as possible, regional municipalities and the Essex Region Conservation Authority will co-host a series of information sessions to:

- Identify current and predicted water level impacts
- Be prepared in the case of a flooding emergency
