

COUNCIL CONNECT: HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE MAY 28, 2019 MEETINGS OF COUNCIL

Tecumseh Town Council held three Public Meetings, a Special Council Meeting and a Regular Meeting of Council on Tuesday, May 28, 2019. The following are the highlights from those meetings:

New Town of Tecumseh Website

- Shaun Fuerth, Director Information & Communications Services was joined by Colleen Colbeck from eSolutions Group to present the new Tecumseh.ca website to members of Council. The new website has a number of new features and is fully compliant with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA).

Lake Flooding Emergency Planning

- Council received a report on Administration's response to the Lake Flooding discussed at the May 14 Regular Meeting. The report outlined that 46 property owners had collected their 100 sandbags since the program began on May 15. Administration continues to work on additional protective measures for the Town with respect to flooding.

Tecumseh Corn Festival 2019

- Council approved the contract with All Canadian Entertainment to provide the Midway for this year's Corn Festival.

Service Line Warranties of Canada

- Council approved a one-year renewal of the contract with Service Lines Warranty of Canada to market their insurance to property owners. SLWC offers optional insurance to homeowners to cover repairs to water and sewer lines that run from their home to the municipal right of way. An introductory letter was mailed out to residents at the beginning of March 2019. SLWC has advised their next mail out will be in September 2019.

A Development Charges Workshop will be held on June 4, 2018 from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. for Council with the agenda for this meeting available on May 30. A Special Meeting of Council is scheduled for June 24, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. to present the design options for the Sportsplex and costings. The agenda for this meeting will be available on June 19. The next Regular Meeting of Council is June 25, 2019 at 7 p.m. Full agenda details will be available on the website Thursday, June 20.
