

The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh

By-Law Number 2025-090

Being a by-law to authorize the use of internet and telephone voting method for the 2026 Municipal and School Board Elections

Whereas Section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act*, 1996, provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of alternate voting methods that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote, if the by-law is passed before May 1 in the year of the election;

And Whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh deems it appropriate and in the public interest to conduct the 2026 Municipal Election using internet and telephone voting methods;

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of The Town of Tecumseh enacts as follows:

1. **That** Council of The Corporation of the Town of Tecumseh (Town) hereby authorizes the use of internet and telephones for the purpose of voting for the 2026 Municipal and School Board Elections; and
2. **That** the Town enter into an agreement with a service provider to be selected by the Director Legislative Services & Clerk for the purpose of providing the alternative methods of voting as authorized by Council; and
3. **That** the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign any agreement necessary with the service provider for the use of internet and telephone voting services.

Read a first, second, third time and finally passed this 22nd day of July, 2025.
